Home Tuition Guidelines for Parents

These guidelines have been produced in response to years of experience of home tutoring and have been developed with your child's educational progress in mind.

- ✦ A member of staff will telephone you to confirm your child's home tuition appointment each week. Please inform our office immediately if any changes to contact details are made (number below.)
- ✦ There should be a responsible adult (18+, other than the teacher) present within the property for the duration of the home tuition session. If there is no adult present, the tutor is not permitted to stay with the young person.
- ✦ Please prepare your child for their session: your child should have eaten and drunk before the lesson and should be fully dressed - we are bringing the classroom into your home; pupils in classrooms neither wear dressing gowns nor eat during lessons!
- ✦ Pets, in particular dogs, should be kept in a separate room. You may love your pet but not everyone may share your view.
- ✦ Your child should have somewhere free from distraction to work, preferably with a chair and a table at which to sit. It is not appropriate to have the television on in the same room while they are trying to learn.
- ✦ Please try to ensure that any work set for your son or daughter is completed to a good standard.

Please give The Canterbury Centre as much notice as possible if your son/daughter is too ill to go ahead with their session. With sufficient notice we may be able to use the time to tutor another pupil.
